Answers from Mike Tierney: 1) There is no sunsetting when it comes to grandfathering. (2) A property owner must meet current setbacks if at all possible otherwise a variance must be applied for. If a lot was of record and buildable before current ordinances went into affect and the property owner cannot meet the new setbacks then the previous setbacks should be met. (3) The first building on a lot (i.e. garage, shed), if it is not a dwelling, only needs an over-the-counter permit.

Leonard Eibs reported on changes possibly taking place within the county. The county is looking at re-zoning based on soil types and going to 80 acre per1 dwelling for agricultural districts.
