Alander's inquired about whether they needed a variance for their proposed pole barn. They plan to build on an existing pad that had been permitted for an outbuilding in 1998 by a previous owner but now did not meet current ordinaces because of the 75' set back required from a slope greater than 18%. They were told they needed to apply for a variance.
