Discussion of the no cost permit regarding manure management and the state's 70/20 manure management laws was not held as Jeremy Tesch was unable to make the meeting.

Concerning the landslides in the township, the township association attorney was consulted for proper language for a site safety disclaimer and language for setbacks from the base of the bluffs. The attorney suggested the township hire an attorney to work out the proper language for a disclaimer and is not aware of any other townships having setbacks from the base of bluffs or slopes. He stated again that the township should not have to worry about liability concerning the safety of a site. Currently Sibley Co. p&z is looking into adding setbacks from the base of a slope and is looking for other counties that have setbacks in their ordinances. Jessenland will wait to see what the county comes up with before proceeding any farther.
